- If you are a current booster club member there is no fee to participate. If you are not a current member, you will need to pay a \$25.00 participation fee. This is to offset the cost of this event. A membership form is attached.
- If you have clothes you wish to donate, they are sold by the bag and do not require an individual price. Those proceeds go to the club to help offset the cost of this event.
