



Chehalis School District # 302 - Approved Winter Snow Routes - 2011/12

During inclement weather conditions, buses may be running late due to road conditions. Pick-up times and locations will be on their regular schedules unless radio announcements states otherwise. In the interest of safety for our bus-riding students, the following route changes will be in effect for ALL routes when it is announced that buses are "Running on Winter Snow Routes". If it is announced that schools are starting two hours late, please remember that buses will also start two hours later than normal. Starting no later than 6:15 am, local radio stations KELA (1470 am), LIVE 95 (95.1 fm), KMNT (102.9 fm), KITI (1420 am) and Olympia station KXXO/Mixx-96 (96.1 fm), along with TV stations KOMO 4, KING 5 and KIRO 7 will have continuous updates posted. The Chronicle's website www.Chronline.com and <http://www.flashnews.net/puget> will also be posting weather related school activities. **NOTE:** "Winter Snow Route" adjustments apply to both the ride in to school and the ride home. Occasionally road condition will improve over the course of the day and when safe to do so drivers will attempt to get the students as close to their regular drop off as possible. We ask that you make every attempt NOT to contact the schools, transportation office, or radio station regarding school closures.

Route # 1, # 2, # 4, # 9, # 17

Will have no changes to the Routes.

Route # 3 - Delete Tillicum & Kennicott Rd, Alternate Location: Will be made at 121 Wallace RD (7:30). Delete Prospect, Alternate Location: Will be at 11th and Market (7:45).

Route # 5 - Delete Devereese (uphill), Alternate Location: Devereese & Shorey (7:25). Students North of Galaxie Rd & Roberts Dr. in Newuakum Heights, Alternate Location: Roberts and Galaxie (7:30). Students on Devereese, Alternate Location: Devereese & Galaxie (7:35). Delete Nix Rd, Alternate Location: Hwy 603 & Nix Rd (7:40). Delete Tune Rd between Hw 6 and Shorey - Alternate Location: Tune Rd & Shorey (7:45).

Route # 6 - Delete Devereese stops NORTH of Galaxie Rd, Alternate Location: Devereese at Galaxie Rd (7:20). 2ND Alternate Location: Devereese and Shorey Rd (7:35).

Route # 8 - Delete All Stops going up Brockway Rd, including Elm View, Waters, Sunset Dr, Brian, and Hemlock. Alternate Location: Sterns and Chilvers (7:15) and Chilvers and Kray (7:20). Delete 250 to 282 Hwy 603, Alternate Location: At the Dairy (7:30).

Route # 10 - Delete All stops going up Whitney, Alternate Location: Scheuber & Whitney (7:20).

Route # 11 - Delete North Star, Alternate Location: North Star and Rush Rd (7:30)

Route # 12 - Delete Hillcrest, Alternate Location: Hillcrest & Jackson Hwy (7:15). T/A at the Dairy on MaComber Rd (7:25). Delete Chehalis Valley Dr, Alternate Location: Chehalis Valley Rd & Jackson Hwy (7:44). Delete Sanderson Rd, Alternate Location: Sanderson & Jackson Hwy (7:48).

Route # 13 - Delete Coulson & Koontz Rd, Alternate Location: Coulson & Hwy 508 (7:05) and Hwy 508 and Jackson Hwy (7:20). Delete Upper Middle Fork Rd, Alternate Location: Middle Fork Rd and Rosebrook Rd (7:30).

Route # 14 - Delete North of Centralia Alpha Rd (North Fork, Lucas Crk, Senn, & Oppelt Rds), Alternate Location: The Fire Station at Centralia Alpha Rd & North Fork (7:25). Delete Tauscher RD, Alternate Location: Tauscher Rd & North Fork Rd (7:35).

Route # 15 - Delete Yates Rd & Hewitt Rd, Alternate Locations: Yates Rd & Logan Hill (7:45), Hewitt Rd & North Fork (7:10), Hewitt Rd & Logan Hill (7:40).

Route # 16 - Delete Pattee Rd, Alternate Location: Pattee Rd and Logan Hill (7:15)

Special Ed Routes # 19, # 20 and # 21

No Changes unless notified by Transportation Office.

FLOOD CONDITIONS: No bus service on Tune Rd, Shoreline Dr, Cedar, Brace, Florida, or Airport. When flood conditions exist the alternate location will be as close as possible to barriers/Road Closed signs. Students should proceed with extreme caution when ever in the vicinity of high water.
